Entry fee: £15 per seat, excluding coxes. All entries and payments to be made via BROE2. Only paid entries will be accepted. British Rowing Day Tickets will be accepted; further details of this scheme can be found on the BR website.

Entries will open at 12:00 noon on Thursday 28th March and close at 12:00 noon on Thursday 25th April. Entries may be suspended earlier if the event is oversubscribed.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cap, combine or remove events in order to fit within the capacity of this event.

BROE2 will remain open for substitutions until 18:00 on Saturday 4th May. All substitutions must be recorded on-line at least 30 minutes before the crew's first race.

Competitors (including coxes) may not enter more than one event in each Wave. No competitor (including coxes) may be under 11 years of age on the date of the event. Boat sharing within a Wave is not permitted. Wave timings are approximate.

Coaches are responsible for ensuring that crews are competent to race and able to boat/land quickly with minimal assistance.

Events with more than 9 entries will be split into bands using CRI as a guide.

For events with heats, winners will stay on the water for finals.

For Masters events, adjacent age categories will be combined if necessary and BR Masters Handicaps will be applied.

The Masters Novice 4x+ event is specifically for competitors who have learned to row within the last 2 years and have a sculling CRI of no more than 10 (excluding cox).

Adaptive events will be raced in two lanes over a 500m course and run on a time handicap basis.

In the event of total cancellation of the Regatta for reasons beyond the control of Marlow Rowing Club, the Committee reserves the right to adjust refunds in order to cover non-cancellable costs.
